The 2023-2024 school year was a year of celebrating our 100th Anniversary: Empowering a New Century--Faith, Learning & Service! In September, reminiscent of the original dedication of the school in the fall of 1923, Fr. Colin Parrish, led a re-dedication of the school at the corner of 1st and Lee Street. This strong launch set the tone for our next 100 years: to continue our mission driven work of promoting educational excellence, fostering the living of Gospel values, building Christian community and inspiring compassionate service.



Throughout the year, we grounded ourselves in faith through weekly Mass, Monday morning Prayer Assembly, our daily Advent reflection and song, service to support Martha's Workers, Lenten Rosary and student-led Masses. Our theme this year was from Genesis: "God saw all that He had made and it was very good." This passage was a daily beacon for our growth and learning. Academic growth was enriched by monthly executive function skill building classes for staff, students and parents sponsored by the school auction Fund It. In response to our strategic technology and program goals, a new one-to-one computer program began for our fifth through eighth grade students, new iPads with keyboards were purchased for our 3rd and 4th graders and we increased instructional aide staffing to support our diverse learners.

The year was filled with special events and activities for all. In November, we had our St. Anne 100th Anniversary Gala Mass and Celebration. In January, we hosted a young alumni Volleyball game. In February, all school students celebrated 100's day with their Families playing minute-to-win-it games and enjoying a Parent Association sponsored pizza lunch. In May, we had our Century Club Auction at Fremont Studios! It was a marvelous capstone to our 100th Anniversary celebrations.

As we look to the next hundred years we ground ourselves in the good work of community members who have gone before us. Through them, God's grace has been abundant and our students' lives are better for it. May our work together continue to cultivate faith, foster hearts of service and strengthen critical thinking in all our students.

SCHOOL SERVICE

Martha's Workers

For over 35 years, Martha's Workers at St. Anne Parish have been making sandwiches weekly for our homeless neighbors (Martin de Porres, Compass Housing, Noel House, Queen Anne Food Bank, Francis House). St. Anne students collect supplies every week and middle schoolers help make the sandwiches.

- + Approximately 500 sandwiches are made per week.
- + 45 large cans tuna - will make sandwiches for 3 months
- + 31 jars of mayo - will last for almost 4 months
- + 86 boxes of baggies - last for over 5 months
- + 65 large containers peanut butter & 30 large containers of jelly - enough for PB&J sandwiches for 3 months

Notes of Encouragement

Middle school students in 6th grade spread kindness through their service learning project, "Notes of Encouragement". Often partnering with their 3rd-grade Buddies, they create beautifully decorated notes filled with love and prayers for those facing challenging times. Initially, the service project was crafted for local community members, but has grown, with requests coming in from people all over needing support, including those undergoing surgery or cancer treatment. From celebrating milestone birthdays to uplifting those feeling hopeless, these heartfelt notes continue to make a meaningful impact in the community.

Killer Whale Tales Fundraiser

A highlight for St. Anne students is the annual Killer Whale Tales resident orca presentation in Kindergarten and 5th grade. To celebrate Earth Day 2024, students did a special art project and held a mini "whale" fundraiser, raising \$2,906.00 for Killer Whale Tales.

Blessing Bags

St. Anne held their annual Advent donation drive and every student contributed hygiene essentials. The items were put into individual "blessing bags" decorated by students and then delivered to nearby homeless Shelters.

St. Vincent de Paul

As part of their service project, 7th graders spent the day at St. Vincent de Paul learning about the organization and handing out food to neighbors in need.

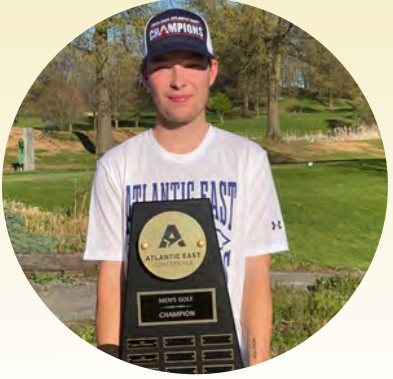
APOLLO JONES '19

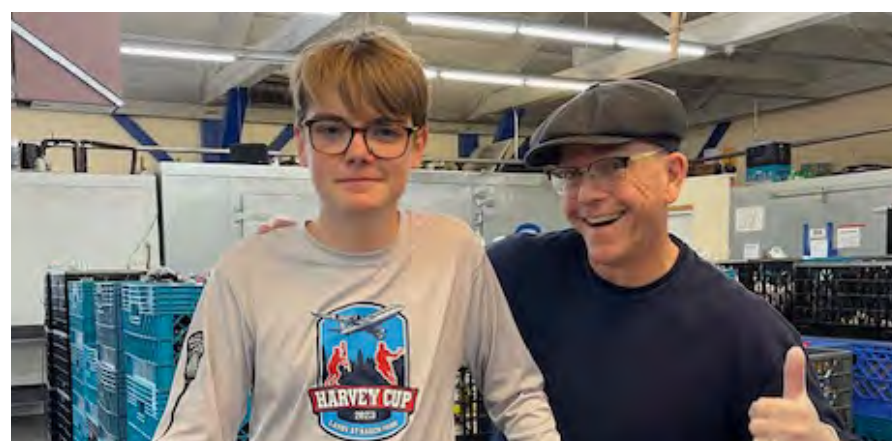
Graduation Day

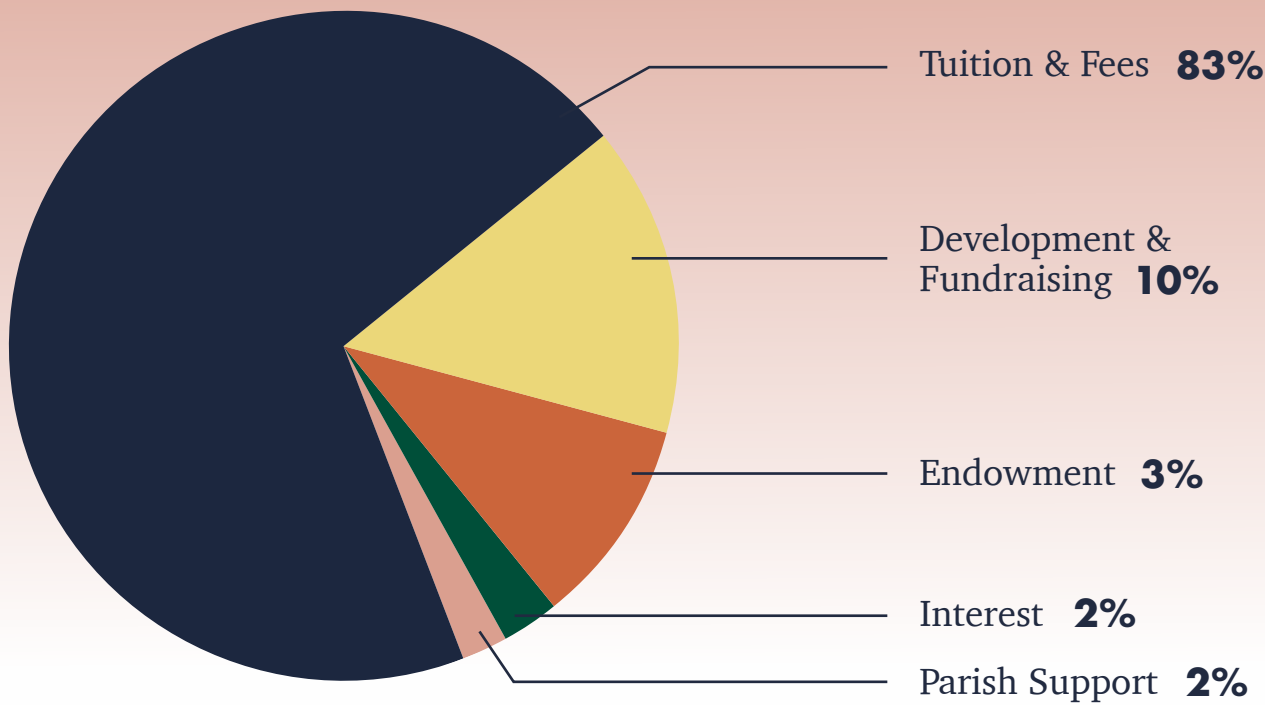

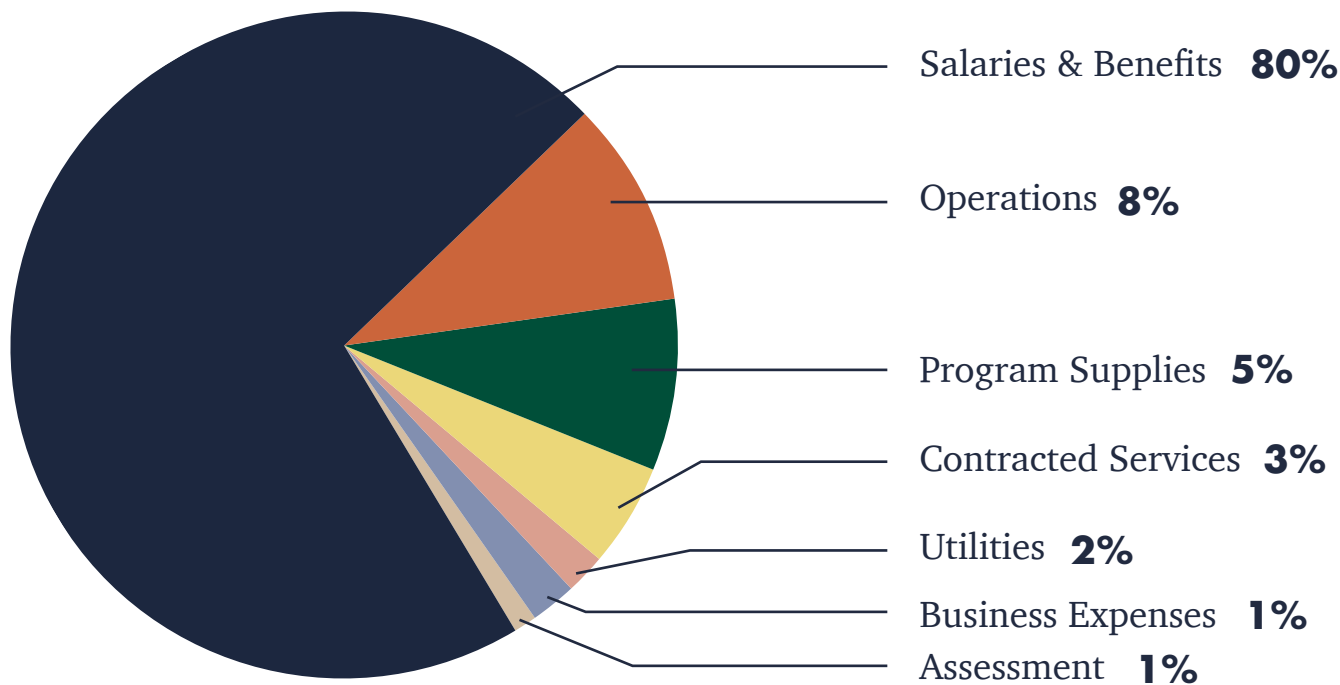
